## Part 1. Interview

## Part 2. Role-Play

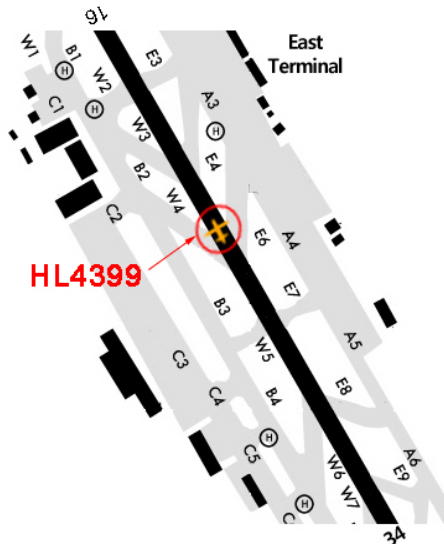
Note: The test taker's callsign for all three sections is Hotel Lima four three niner niner. The interviewer should tell the test taker his/her callsign prior to starting.

### *Task A. Situation 1*

Imagine your minimum climb speed for this flight is two hundred and seventy knots and you would like to maintain this speed. The controller will be contacting you soon. Listen to the message then notify the controller of your minimum climb speed.

### *Task B. Situation 2 (Picture)*

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



You have just landed on runway three four and will be taxiing to the East Terminal. Your plan was to vacate via Echo four to taxi to the terminal. Listen to the controller's message and let him know about your intentions.

### *Task C. Situation 3*

Imagine you were deviating due to weather and now wish to fly directly to the waypoint, NIRAT. Tell the controller you're clear of the weather, then listen carefully to the controller's response and respond as necessary.

### Part 3. Providing Information and Sharing Opinions

#### *Task A. Work-Related Situation*
