Part 1. Interview

Task A. Greetings & Introduction

Note: The interviewer narrates the situation and plays the role of the pilot. The test taker is the controller and responds to the situation and/or message.

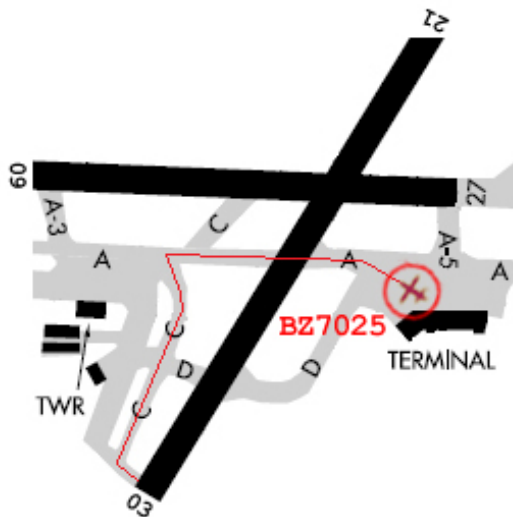
Task A. Situation 1

Imagine you are working as a tower controller. The runway in use is runway zero two right. Surface wind is three six zero at seven knots. QNH is one zero two three hectopascals.

Papa Oscar one eight niner eight will be calling you with a position report. Respond to the pilot's message by providing surface wind and QNH information and approving the pilot for a straight-in approach.

Task B Situation 2 (Picture)

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



Bravo Zulu seven zero two five is now ready to taxi for departure. Listen to the pilot's message, then provide detailed taxi instructions using the red line as a guide.

Task C. Situation 3

Oscar Echo five four seven two is ready for departure and wants to line up on the active runway, zero two right. Unfortunately an aircraft is now stuck on the active runway. Inform the pilot about the situation and instruct the pilot to line up on the parallel runway, runway zero two left. Then, listen to the pilot's message and make an appropriate response.

Part 3. Providing Information and Sharing Opinions

Task A. Work-Related Situation

What would you do in a situation where an aircraft declares an emergency and wants to land at your airport, but the runway is too short to accommodate it? Explain in detail.

Task B. Presenting an Idea about a Picture

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



Describe the photograph in as much detail as possible and then explain any problems that may arise from the positions of the aircraft in the photograph.

Task C. Stating an Opinion

Technology is constantly improving in day to day life, what do you think is the biggest technological improvement that has been incorporated into your daily duties? Explain in detail.
