Part 1. Interview

Task A. Greetings & Introduction

Note: The interviewer narrates the situation and plays the role of the pilot. The test taker is the controller and responds to the situation and/or message.


Task A. Situation 1

Imagine you are working as a tower controller. The runway in use is runway one zero. Surface wind is zero eight zero at one five knots. QNH is one zero zero nine hectopascals. Aircraft making a go around should climb runway heading and maintain five thousand feet.

Hotel Whiskey zero nine four eight is on approach to the airport when a problem with the landing gear is discovered. The pilots wish to make a low pass for a visual check of the landing gear. Respond to the pilot's message including a five hundred foot altitude restriction and go around instructions if required.

Task B Situation 2 (Picture)

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



Foxtrot Echo eight seven seven eight is waiting for permission to cross the runway. Listen to the pilot's message, then provide detailed taxi instructions using the red line as a guide.

Task C. Situation 3

The runway in use is runway one zero. Surface wind is zero eight zero at one five knots. QNH is one zero zero niner hectopascals. The latest information code is Kilo.

Bravo Golf three four eight zero is preparing for departure. Inform the pilot about the active runway, the current ATIS code, and to report when ready for taxi. Then, respond to the pilot's message as necessary.
