Part 1. Interview

Note: The interviewer narrates the situation and plays the role of the pilot. The test taker is the controller and responds to the situation and/or message.


Task A. Situation 1

Imagine you are working as a tower controller. The runway in use is runway zero five. Surface wind is zero three zero at niner knots. QNH is one zero one three hectopascals.

An aircraft has just landed on the active runway and is still on the runway. November Lima niner one six two is holding short of runway zero five and will be calling you with a request. Listen to the pilot's message, then inform the pilot about the situation while instructing the pilot to line up and wait on the active runway.

Task B Situation 2 (Picture)

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



Yankee November three eight one two is now ready for departure. Listen to the pilot's message, then clear the pilot for an intersection departure on the appropriate runway informing the pilot there is six thousand feet of runway available.

Task C. Situation 3

Papa November six one zero five is rolling for take-off when you notice thick black smoke coming from one of the engines. You want the aircraft to abort the take-off if able to avoid a dangerous situation. Make a radio call to the pilot, instructing him to abort the take-off. Then, respond to the pilot's message as required.
