## Part 1. Interview

Note: The interviewer narrates the situation and plays the role of the pilot. The test taker is the controller and responds to the situation and/or message.


### **Task A. Situation 1**

Imagine you are working as a tower controller. The runway in use is runway one six. Surface wind is one seven zero at five knots. QNH is one zero one eight hectopascals. The current temperature is minus six, dew point minus one two.

Victor Kilo eight five six two will be calling you with a request. Listen to the pilot's message, then respond as necessary.

### **Task B Situation 2 (Picture)**

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



Juliet Foxtrot zero six three eight has just vacated the runway. Listen to the pilot's message, then provide detailed taxi instructions using the red line as a guide.

### **Task C. Situation 3**

Mike Yankee three seven four two has called you requesting pushback and start-up. You expect to be able to approve the pilot's request at one eight three zero UTC. Inform the pilot about this fact, then listen to the pilot's message and respond as necessary.

### Part 3. Providing Information and Sharing Opinions

#### ***Task A. Work-Related Situation***
