Part 1. Interview

Task A. Greetings & Introduction

Hi, my name is _____, and I'm your interviewer. How are you today?

Task B. Providing Job-Related Information

Part 2. Role-Play

Note: The interviewer narrates the situation and plays the role of the pilot. The test taker is the controller and responds to the situation and/or message.

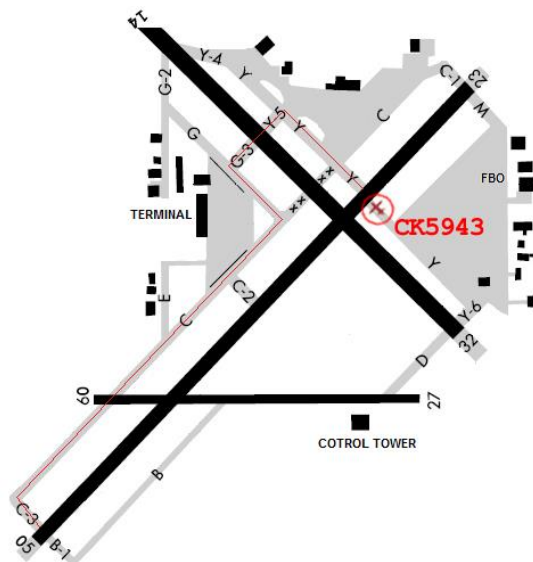
Task A. Situation 1

Imagine you are working as a tower controller. The runway in use is runway one niner. Surface wind is two three zero at one zero knots. QNH is one zero one one hectopascals.

X-Ray Whiskey five seven eight eight is on approach to the airport. The leading traffic has just landed, but due to a hard landing, one of its tires burst on impact with the runway and the aircraft is now stuck. Runway two eight is available, but it is shorter than the active runway. X-Ray Whiskey five seven eight eight will be calling you soon. Listen to the pilot's message, then inform him about the situation and ask what he would like to do.

Task B Situation 2 (Picture)

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



Charlie Kilo five niner four three is holding short of runway zero five. Listen to the pilot's message, then provide detailed taxi instructions using the red line as a guide.

Task C. Situation 3

Romeo Mike four zero five four has just vacated the runway and has contacted Ground for taxi instructions to the terminal. An Airbus three thirty is taxiing on Sierra. Instruct the pilot to hold short of the taxiway until the Airbus three thirty has passed and then, continue taxi to the terminal. Then listen to the pilot's message and make an appropriate response.
