Part 1. Interview

Part 2. Role-Play

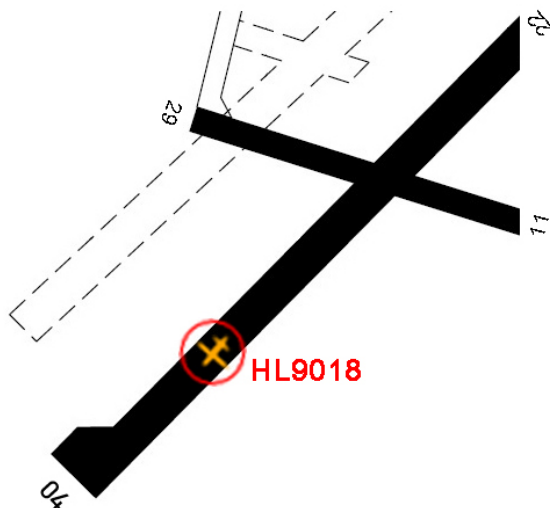
Note: The test taker's callsign for all three sections is Hotel Lima niner zero one eight. The interviewer should tell the test taker his/her callsign prior to starting.

Task A. Situation 1

Imagine you are ready for departure and have contacted ramp control for pushback clearance and were told to standby. Now, the purser informs you that there is a problem with a passenger and you are unable to depart. Listen to the controller's message then inform the controller about the situation.

Task B. Situation 2 (Picture)

Look at the picture provided. You have 15 seconds to study the picture.



You are currently backtracking on runway zero four in preparation for a departure. However, you need to perform a short engine run up before you depart. Listen to the controller's instruction then make an appropriate response.

Task C. Situation 3

Imagine you are flying over the Pacific at flight level three four zero. You have encountered wake turbulence from a preceding aircraft and as a result, would like to offset two miles right of track. Make a request to the controller, then listen carefully to the controller's response and respond as necessary.

After making a passenger announcement sharing the planned flight route with the passengers, you receive a report from the purser stating that a passenger is complaining that the planned route is a detour and will take longer than necessary. What would you do in this situation?
