Task B Providing Job-Related Information

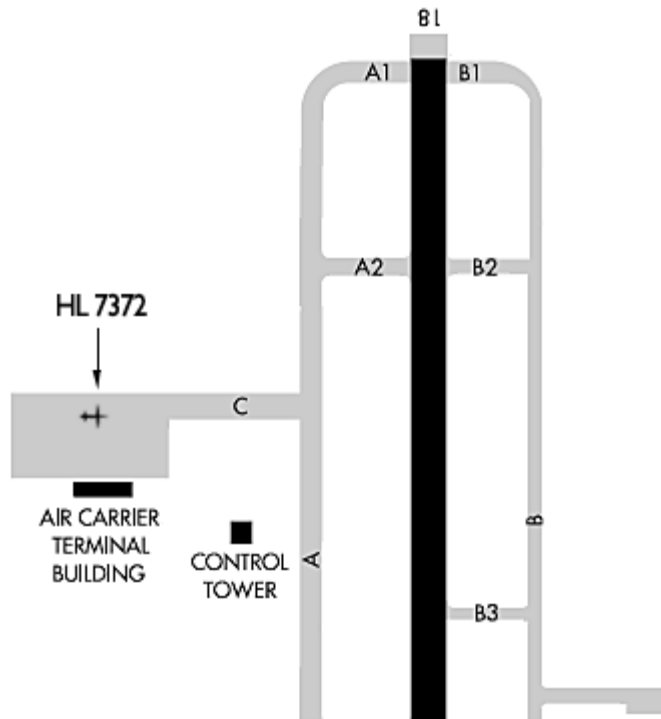
International flights are often very long and uneventful. What do you do during a long flight to stay focused and avoid feeling drowsy?
