Task B Providing Job-Related Information

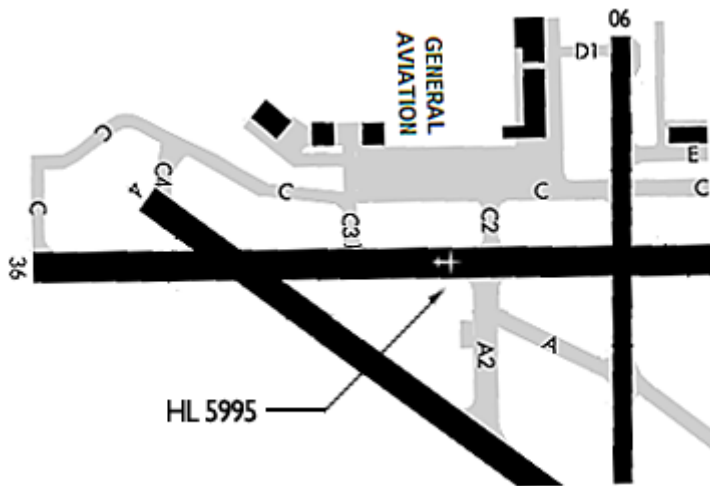
Do you believe communication between a pilot and his crew members is important? Why or why not?

Task B Situation 2

Task C Situation 3

You are en route to your destination airport. Due to some delays you were not able to depart on time. In order to save some time you wish to fly directly to PONIN. Contact the controller and make your request, then respond to the controller after he has given his response.
