Task B Providing Job-Related Information

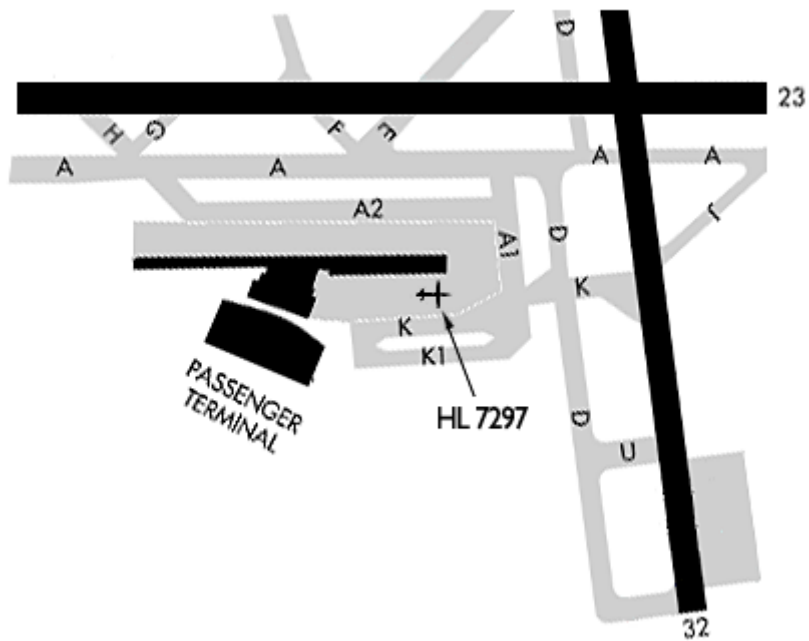
If you are not certain about a controller's instructions, why is it dangerous to carry out the instruction without asking the controller for clarification?

Task A Situation 1

Task C Situation 3

You do not expect conditions to improve anytime soon and so you decide to divert to your alternate airport which is 20 minutes away. Inform the controller about your low fuel status and your intentions.
