### **Task B    Providing Job-Related Information**

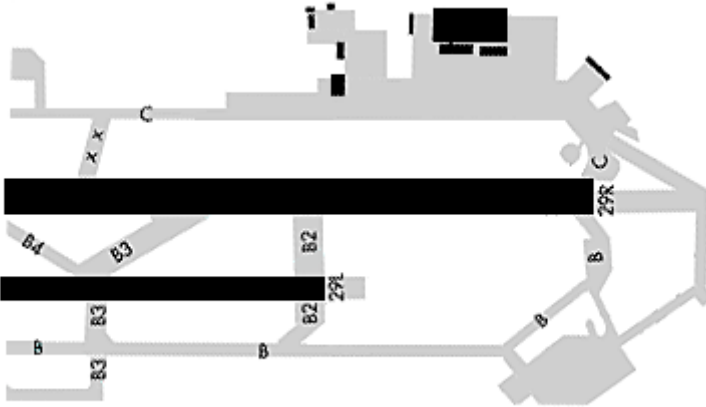
Because safety is the number one priority for an airline, many aspects of a pilot's job have become routine. What about flying passenger jets do you enjoy the most? Why?

### **Task A    Situation 1**

## Task B Situation 2



You are on approach to your destination airport when the controller calls you on the radio. A truck is stuck on the active runway and it will be a few minutes before they can clear the vehicle. Listen to the controller's instructions and respond as necessary.

### **Task C Situation 3**

You are on approach to your destination. Your callsign has recently been changed from HL 7824 to ZD 7824. You wish to land on runway one six because it is closest to the terminal. Make a request to the controller then respond to the controller's message as necessary.
