### **Task B    Providing Job-Related Information**

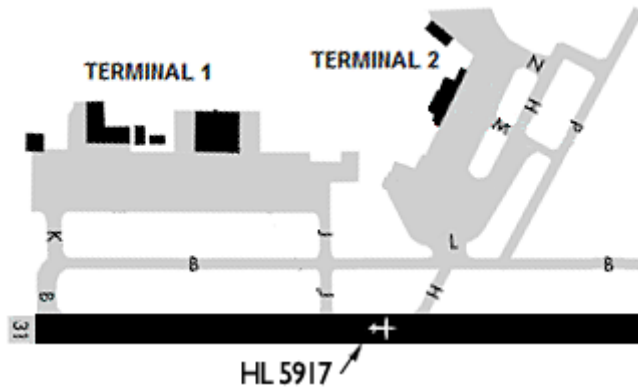
What are the differences in daytime and nighttime flying? Is one safer than the other? Why?

## **PART2      Role Play**

### **Task A    Situation 1**

Imagine you are the pilot of HL 5917. You are en route to your destination airport when the controller contacts you on the radio. You have entered airspace controlled by a different controller and he wants you to ident by setting your transponder. Listen to the controller's instructions and respond as necessary.

## Task B Situation 2



You have just landed on runway 31. As you were landing a sudden gust of wind caused your aircraft to tip to one side causing one of your wingtips to strike the ground. You were able to right the aircraft and land without further incident, but several of the passengers are alarmed. The controller will be contacting you shortly. Inform him of the situation and respond to his inquiry.

### **Task C Situation 3**

You are on approach to your destination when the controller informs you that the previous aircraft is stuck on the active runway, 10L, and you should use the parallel runway 10R instead. However, it seems like the runway lights on 10R are a bit dim. Request the runways lights be set to maximum intensity, then listen to the controller's message and respond as necessary.
