Part 2. Role-Play

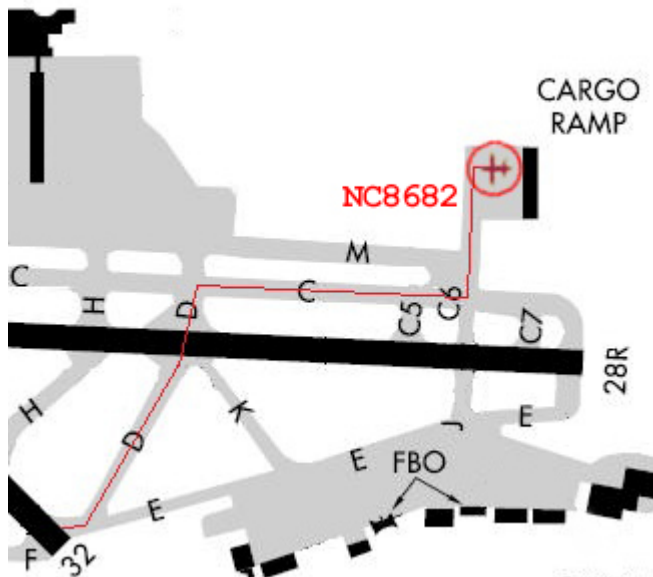
Note: The interviewer narrates the situation and plays the role of the pilot. The test taker is the controller and responds to the situation and/or message.

Task A. Situation 1
